This agreement is entered into on _____ by and between Creekside Veterinary Service and _____ (client). The purpose of this agreement is to advise the client of the inherent risk involved in equine reproduction.

Although assisted equine reproduction is a common procedure, there are risks associated with rectal palpation. These include, but are not limited to, rectal tearing, which is a life threatening, unpredictable, expensive and oftentimes fatal accident. Creekside Veterinary Service strongly recommends that any broodmare in a breeding program be insured for major medical expenses and loss of life.

Broodmare owner (client) agrees to assume all risk of loss, due to injury or death, of their broodmare enrolled in an assisted equine reproduction program.

Patient Insurance

I understand that if my animals are covered by medical/surgical insurance it is my responsibility to notify the insurance agent or adjuster of any illness, injury, or anticipated procedure that may affect that coverage.
